



Senior release is a privilege that Clarksville School makes available to certain qualified seniors only. Requests are not automatically granted and may be revoked at any time if students are not meeting eligibility criteria. As our seniors are preparing to enter post-secondary education or the workforce it is important that they have school opportunities to develop and demonstrate appropriate and responsible use of their time and time management skills. Senior release allows students to practice these skills.

SENIOR RELEASE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (1st and 2nd Semester)

1. In academic good standing as indicated by the following criteria:
 - a. 0 missing assignments,
 - b. No requests from teachers for intervention time,
 - c. No failing grades at checkpoints (mid term, quarter, semester), &
 - d. Be on track to earn enough credits to meet graduation requirements.
2. Demonstrate good conduct in the current school year as indicated by the following criteria:
 - a. 0 major office referrals &
 - b. 0 good conduct violations.
3. Maintain appropriate attendance rates as indicated by the following criteria:
 - a. < 9 absences per semester &
 - b. < 9 tardies to any/all classes per semester.
4. Parent permission is signed and turned into the office.

RELEASE TIMES OFFERED

Seniors who are deemed eligible will be offered release time during the following:

- Lunch 12:28 - 12:53,
- Tribe Time 3:20 - 3:40,
- Study hall offered either 1st, 7th (if work experience 8th hour), or 8th hour.

SENIOR RELEASE EXPECTATIONS

- Seniors are only allowed up to 1 study hall class per semester, unless the student is taking college courses. At that point, only 1 study hall will be allowed to utilize senior release time.
- Seniors must indicate which class/study hall they will be utilizing for senior release and record this in the front office. This class period will remain consistent throughout the entire semester.
- Students will sign in/out using Smart Pass. If they do not, this privilege may be revoked.
- Students will still be required to stay for class meetings, NHS, FFA, Student Council meetings, and/or PALS during Tribe Time if they are active members.
- Students will have to “re-apply” for senior release at the beginning of the second semester.
- Students are welcome to stay on campus during senior release if they remain in the following locations:
 - HS library, following study hall rules.
 - Common Space outside the HS office.
 - Meeting with a teacher if the teacher has sent a Smart Pass.
 - Students are not allowed to roam the building or be in any other location.
